

Information you need so you can contact the right people:

- Size.** Will it be less than or greater than one acre?
- Location.** Will it be built in a regulated area?
- Spoils.** What will be done with the material?

SIZE:

If the pond is going to be under 1 acre:

- Contact Rodney Mayer, Wood County Land and Water Conservation Department, at rodney.mayer@woodcountymi.gov for a Non-Metallic Mining Reclamation Permit Site Exemption. This form can be found on our website.
- Contact your town to inquire if a conditional use permit is needed.

If the pond is going to be over 1 acre:



Location

To find out if the pond will be located in a flood zone, a wetland, or in a shoreland zoning buffer, go online.

- If you see Blue shading, it could be in a shoreland zoning buffer.
