POWTS means private on-site wastewater treatment system and has the meaning specified under s. 145.01 (12), Stats for “private sewage systems.” Pursuant to Wisconsin Administrative Code Chapter DSPS 383.52 (3), a person who holds registration issued by the department as a registered POWTS maintainer may evaluate and monitor POWTS components for the purpose of providing POWTS management (For example: Servicing of Sand Filter, Bio Microbics, and Multi-Flow treatment units). A POWTS Maintainer can inspect septic systems for the three year inspection requirement and is authorized to maintain POWTS in accordance with manufacturer’s maintenance requirements.

A POWTS Maintainer is expected to inspect all critical system components including the condition of septic tank baffles, dose tank pump settings, all electrical components, and treatment cell conditions. Inspections of pretreatment units involve a maintenance procedure established by the unit’s manufacturer and are critical if the system is to perform as designed. After the POWTS maintenance has been completed, an inspection report is required to be filed with the Wood County Planning & Zoning Department for a permanent record of the event.
