- It is the responsibility of the snowmobile clubs to provide for trail easements, signing, brushing, grooming and other maintenance.

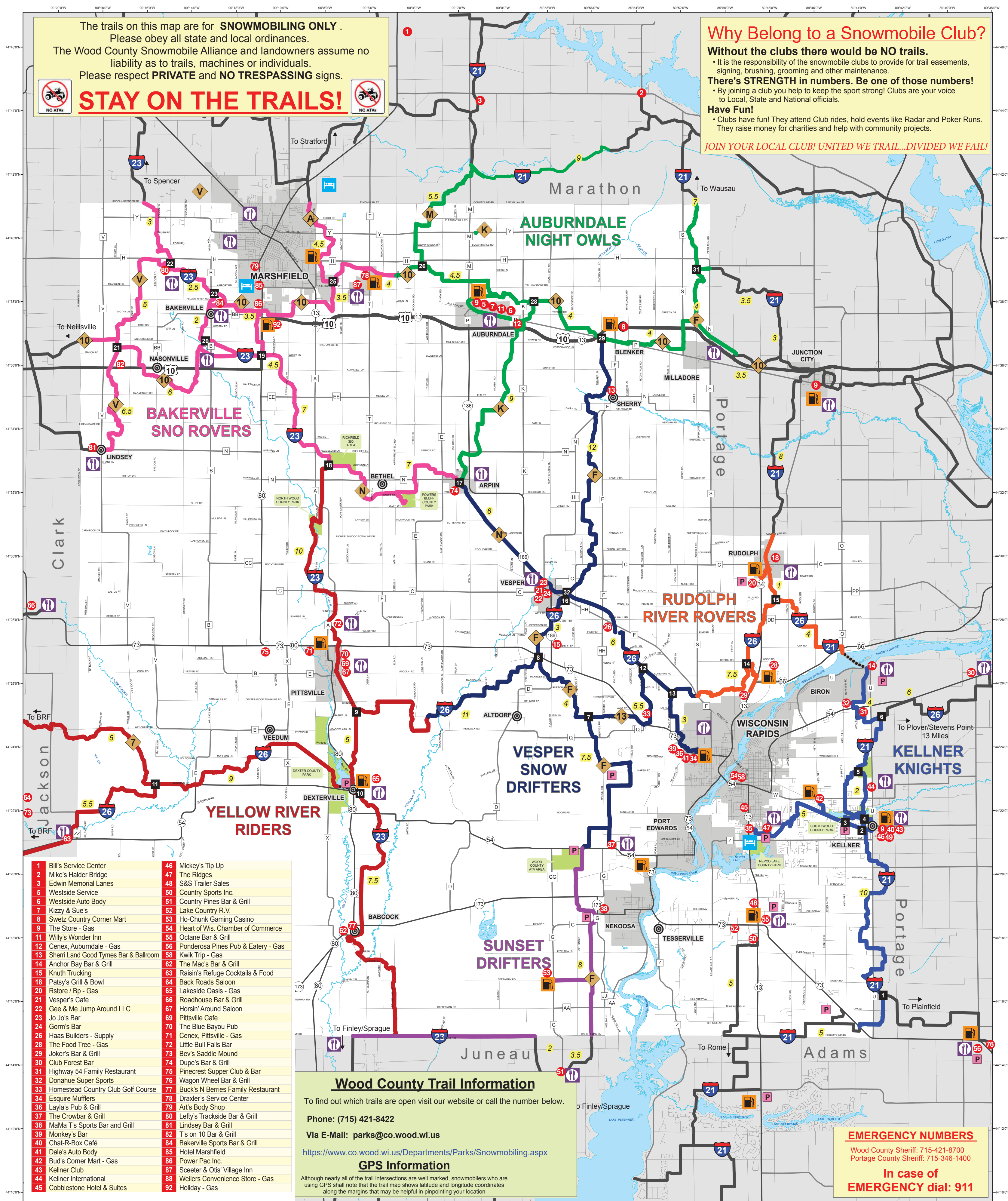
There's STRENGTH in numbers. Be one of those numbers!
