Wood County Closing some Snowmobile Trails

For Immediate Release:

- **Kellner Knights, Rudolph River Rovers and Sunset Drifters** have closed their snowmobile trails today, Tuesday February 28th at 12 pm due to deteriorating snow conditions.
- **Vesper Snow Drifters** section of trail starting at intersection 8, State Highway 73 south to State Highway 54 (ATV Intensive Use Area) remains closed.
- **All other snowmobile trails in Wood County** currently remain open.

County Trail maps can be accessed on the Wood County Parks and Forestry Department website.

Please travel with caution, as conditions vary from FAIR to POOR. Some areas are icy, making grooming very difficult so some areas are only partially groomed. Please be careful and ride at your own risk. Respect landowners and stay on marked trails.

Wood County multi-use trails at NEPCO, Powers Bluff, and Richfield 360 are groomed and track set. Trail pass information is located at trail head locations.

Powers Bluff Winter Sports Area will be open Saturday and Sunday (March 4th & 5th) for tubing and skiing. Two sessions: 10-1, 1-4, all day passes also available.
