REPORTED TO COMMITTEE: 6/12/2023

1. WARNING & COMMUNICATIONS

- a. A spill of 2000 gallons of manure was reported by Centrum Pit Pumping in the City of Nekoosa on May 4, 2023. Spill was caused by equipment failure when a valve on a hose failed and manure was released. Manure was released onto fields and into roadside ditch. Some escaped on to the roadway as well. There was no water or drainage nearby. Reporting party is handling cleanup, using a vacuum truck to pump manure out of affected area.
- b. A spill of an unknown amount of manure was reported in the Village of Rudolph on May 5, 2023. Spill was caused by the intentional or illegal act (dumping). Reported that the manure is liquid and pooling up in ditches. Cleanup is unknown at this time.
- c. A spill of 5 gallons of Diesel fuel was reported by Dan Guck in the City of Wisconsin Rapids on May 12, 2023. Spill was caused by equipment failure when a leak from a pick up truck was discovered. Fuel was released onto gravel driveway and the edge of the lawn. Diggers hotline has been contacted.

2. FEDERAL/STATE FUNDING

- a. Received the FY22 reimbursement from the State for the EMPG grant in the amount of \$80,495.12.
- b. Received the FY22 reimbursement from the State for the EPCRA grant in the amount of \$25,923.71.
- c. Received information on a grant opportunity that we may be applying for to put transfer switches on fueling stations at the highway department to be used to hook up a generator to if there is a long term power failure. This way there will always be fuel available if needed for county vehicles.
- d. Completed the pre-application for the FY23 Computer and Hazmat assistance grant and sent it in to the State.

3. TRAINING

- a. Director and Emergency Preparedness Coordinator attended/hosted the Family Assistance Center (FAC) Functional Exercise on May 1, 2023 in conjunction with the Wood County Health Department.
- b. Emergency Preparedness Coordinator attended a course on the Public Information Officer on May 8-10, 2023 in Waupun, WI.

4. EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLANNING

- a. Emergency Preparedness Coordinated attended an After Action Report meeting with Sara Luchini from the Wood County Health Department on May 16, 2023 to discuss strengths and areas of improvement from the Family Assistance Center Functional Exercise that took place on May 1, 2023.
- b. Spoke with counterparts in the Northeast Region on where they order sandbags. We are looking to order some more and are researching the best prices/quantities for purchase.
- c. Talked with Northeast Region directors about tornado sirens. There are communities that are looking into outdoor warning sirens and those EM directors are gathering data.
- d. Talked with various communities in Wisconsin that are currently using Everbridge products and if they feel that they are worth having. Most are using Nixle, which is owned by Everbridge, but the ones that are using the Resident Connect feature feel that it is useful and are using it and plan on using it more in the future. They feel that it is a great product and useful for Life Safety issues in getting the message out to as many people as possible in a short amount of time. We also spoke with departments on the program, and if they feel that it would be beneficial to them. Thus far the response has been positive with many feeling that in times of life safety it would be a major asset for the County to have.

- Attended Wood County Law Enforcement Executive meeting at MSTC.
- Worked with Wood County Facilities Manager, Information Technology and Communication Director to mitigate disturbance of services due to demolition of the South Stairwell of the courthouse for the new construction. A temporary operations center was set up in the Emergency Operations Center should the noise be too loud for operations to continue in the existing room.
- Completed VoIP Test calls with Telephone hardware provider, Racom, along with ESN provider, Intrado, to fix on going issue with ALI (Automatic Location Identification) coming into the 911 lines.
- Discovered an error in CAD system that had a stretch of road listed in Grand Rapids, not the City of Wisconsin Rapids. That area had been annexed into the City several years ago, but dispatch was either not notified or didn't get that portion removed when that occurred. It has been removed.
- Completed an interview with WSAW Channel 7 regarding accidental 911 calls and hang ups.

- Participated in Critical Incident Stress Management (CISM) quarterly meeting.

#4 – Falls: Unfortunately, we saw another three deaths from our elderly population that are directly attributable to falls this past month. These three falls resulted in the person suffering significant closed head injuries that resulted in their demise. The 2-3 fall related deaths per month seems to be average, albeit, still too high in my opinion. I believe that the 8 we had back in February was an unfortunate fluke.

#10 – Overdoses: May saw us with another overdose. This was based on evidence at the scene and toxicology testing. We did not autopsy this case since we gave time for law enforcement to investigate the case first in lieu of arbitrarily scheduling an autopsy. As previously stated, we have several days to do a more thorough investigation both from our standpoint with respect to medical history and allowing law enforcement to investigate further into their case prior to scheduling an autopsy if warranted.
