### Bakerville Sno Rovers Opening Trail Sections

For Immediate Release:

- **Bakerville Sno Rovers** trails are open as of Monday, January 23, 2023. Trails are Open West to Clark County, North to Marathon County, Open East to Hewitt, and South to Arpin. Trail connection between intersection 20 and 23 is closed for the year.
- All other trails in Wood County remain closed due to poor trail conditions.

County Trail maps can be accessed on the Wood County Parks and Forestry Department website.

Please travel with caution, as conditions will vary. Respect landowners and stay on marked trails.

Wood County multi-use trails at NEPCO, Powers Bluff, and Richfield 360 are groomed and track set. Trail pass information is located at trail head locations.

Powers Bluff Winter Sports Area will be open Saturday and Sunday (Jan 28<sup>th</sup> & 29<sup>th</sup>) for tubing and skiing. Two sessions: 10-1, 1-4, all day passes also available.
